Public Comments* - Todd has had several complaints about Gratz's cars being parked in the road right of way and Dawn explained the issue that the town had in the past and could not get assistance from Zoning, DNR or the State, so nothing was accomplished. Dawn mentioned BCD Services was interested in doing the town's bridge inspections. Board was not interested in pursuing.

Monthly Patrolman's Report – Discuss & possible action if needed – Todd had Tim Salmon help with trees on Kettle Road; trees on Locust Avenue need to have someone professional do it. Chad mentioned United Tree Service. Board gave permission for Todd to have them come out and give a quote. Todd will need salt and Dawn will see how much we are to get and order it to arrive mid-April before the end of April deadline. Todd talked with Jason at Kendall Trucking about cleaning out the bridges but nothing was scheduled.

Monthly Clerk's Report – Discuss & possible action if needed – Dawn reported that the Monroe County Landfill is now open to the public and the Hazardous Collection Event is April 11th from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Discuss & possible action on Lawn Mower – Todd presented Tractor Central's quote given for a new mower but wasn't sure how long the quote pricing was good for. The mower would come with a 4-yr warranty, and the Select Series was the best model, but the X350 was the cheapest of that line. Chad and Todd looked at the Amish place but they didn't have anything. Chad felt we should just go new. Motion to approve Tractor Central's quote by Chad 2nd by Chris. Todd will call Tractor Central and arrange for delivery.
