

Grafton City Council Proceedings  
March 9, 2026

Mayor Gregg Urbatsch convened the regular meeting of the Grafton City Council at 7 PM, March 9, 2026 at Grafton City Hall. Answering roll call were Dalluge, Hulshizer, Kruger, Schaub, and Venz. Visitor was Bruce White. Kruger motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hulshizer to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Dalluge motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Venz to approve the minutes from the February 9, 2026 regular meeting. Motion carried.

Clerk presented the financial reports, past due utility accounts, and bills to be paid. Kruger motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Schaub to approve the financial reports as presented and pay all bills due to date. Motion carried.

Schaub motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Venz to approve the city liquor license renewal. Motion carried.

Council then reviewed the annual electric, water, sewer, and garbage financial reports compiled by the clerk.

Resolution #2026-8 to certify a lien against real estate at 307 3<sup>rd</sup> Street was reviewed. Venz motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kruger to approve the resolution. Upon roll call vote, all members voted aye. Resolution #2026-8 is passed and approved. The city clerk will file the lien with the Worth County Treasurer.

Clerk then explained the figures for the amendment to the Fiscal 2026 budget. Schaub motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hulshizer to set the public hearing for the budget amendment at 7:15 PM on April 13, 2026. Motion carried.

There was no old business. Under new business, there have been some complaints about dogs being off leash and not cleaning up dog excrement when walking dogs around town. There being no further business, Schaub motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hulshizer for adjournment. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 7:41 PM.
