I have been employed with the Monterey County Emergency Communications Department since March of 1985. MCECD is a consolidated dispatch center, providing dispatch services for 13 law enforcement agencies and 12 fire districts. I started my career as a Communications Dispatcher, and shortly after became interested in the training aspect of the job, becoming a Communications Training Officer. I promoted to the Shift Supervisor position in 2006 and during my tenure with this department I have worked as the Acting Training Coordinator, Acting Custodian of Records, and the Scheduling Supervisor. I most recently promoted to Emergency Communications Manager in charge of Fire Operations in December of 2023.
