

The Diamondville Town Council met in regular session on Monday, May 20th, at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Hall, pursuant to due notice and call.

The meeting was called to order at 6:03p.m.

Upon roll call the following were found to be present constituting a quorum: Mayor Clint Bowen, Council Members, Eric Backman, Rob Sawaya, Sherrol Sloan, and Clerk Treasurer Cortney Bartschi

Reading of the Minutes:

Council Sawaya motioned to approve the minutes from May 6th regular session meeting seconded by Council Sloan, all voted aye, motion carried.

Approval of the Agenda:

Council Sloan motioned to approve the agenda, Seconded by Council Backman, all voted aye, motion carried.

Introduction of Guests:

Julie Backman asked about the progress regarding the graffiti on the bridge located on Conroy St

- A. Stephen Allen, Chief of Staff for Lincoln County, gave an update on the current economic development within the County. Terra Power to have a Groundbreaking on June 10th, 2024, information regarding the Highway 30 rerouting project by tunnel hill, and another impact in December with the construction of the Pacific Soda Plant. Mr. Allen also offered help and/or guidance with bonding or other information regarding the new Day Break Subdivision Construction and checking options to help with the Diamondville RV Dump Project.
- B. Council Backman motioned to approve the switch to Verizon Wireless for The Town Hall landlines, seconded by Council Sloan, all voted aye, motion carried.
- C. Council Backman motioned to Start Charging the Credit Card 4% Surcharge fee to the Sanitation Payments starting on June 1st with the new sanitation billing quarter, seconded by Council Sawaya, all voted aye, motioned carried.
- D. Council Backman motioned to split the 1.8% increase in the Law Enforcement Plan with Wyoming Retirement with .9% the employee's responsibility and .9% will be the Town of Diamondville' s responsibility.
- E. Council Backman motioned to table the Oyster Ridge Donation Request, seconded by Council Sloan, all voted aye, motion carried.

Correspondence:

Council Sloan gave an update on the Freedom Fest Fourth of July Celebrations. Chief Kolata informed of the upcoming Municipal Court date of May 22nd at 10AM, Council Sawaya gave information on the Track Parade for State Championship.
