January 26, 2026

1. The meeting was called to order by Hall Board President Lenoard Valasek at 1800 Hours.
 - A. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted by all members present.
 - B. Roll Call of members was conducted, and a quorum was present. Chuck Barnhart and Becky Neilson were excuse.
2. Minutes from the previous meeting on December 8th, 2025, were reviewed: A motion to approve the minutes was made by Dennis (D.R.) Reynolds and seconded by George Alves. The minutes were approved by a vote of the Hall Board Members.
