

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
February 26, 2026

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session.

The following members were present: Council Member Watson, Council Member Moore, Mayor Lay and Council Member Sevier. Council Member Williams was absent.

With a quorum present Mayor Lay called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the January 12, 2026 minutes was made by Council Member Watson with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed.

There were no signatures on the Public Comments sign-in sheet.

Phillip Daniels was on the agenda to address the Council. He made a brief statement about cyber-crime in Lawrenceburg and Lawrence County.

City Fire Chief, Jay Moore, informed the Council that all of the Administration staff in the Fire Department has moved to Station 4. Station 4 is now the headquarters and special operation station. The Department has been in in-service training for the past two weeks. Several of our personnel have continued their education on their own time at their own expense and these are: Zach Kirk and Blaine Kilburn have passed their National Registry EMT. With these other firemen attaining their Associate Degree; Barrett Stutts, August 2025; Casey Dickson Matt Long; and Justin Belew in December 2025. Taking this initiative on their own to accomplish this speaks volumes on the character of our employees. The Fire Department is also working on reviving the dive team.

City Attorney Betz presented the business to the Council.
