1. The Mayor or Council may limit the amount of time for comments if they become extensive.
2. If the speaker begins to infringe on the right to privacy of another, the Mayor or Council may interrupt and end the comments on that issue.
3. These comments must be pertinent to the topic under consideration. There is an opportunity for open comments at the end of the meeting.
4. While the Council is in session, members of the public must preserve order and decorum. No person shall delay or interrupt the proceedings or the peace of the Council nor disturb any member of the public or of the Council while speaking or refuse to obey the orders of the Mayor or the President of the Council.
5. Any person who shall knowingly disturb or disrupt a public meeting of the Council shall be asked to leave the meeting by the Mayor or the Council President and face possible criminal charges. See § 45-8-101, MCA.
