

Dear Resident/Landowner,

The City of Arlington has received wildfire hazard mitigation funding from the Oregon State Fire Marshal to assist landowners and residents in the City of Arlington with reducing wildfire risk to their homes. Residents and property owners 3 miles of the City Center (City Hall, 500 W 1st St, Arlington, OR 97812) can apply for up to \$500 of funding to assist with wildfire mitigation projects. This is the final year that this program will be available.

Projects must fall within these categories:

Fuel Reduction, Vegetation Management and Defensible Space Enhancement: Projects that focus on reducing the accumulation of hazardous/flammable vegetation, such as tree trimming, mowing and weed removal. Projects must reduce wildfire risk on private property and can include hiring contractors to complete the work.

Small Scale Vegetation Management Equipment: One-time purchase of small equipment, including string trimmers, lawn mowers, clippers, and other vegetation management devices.

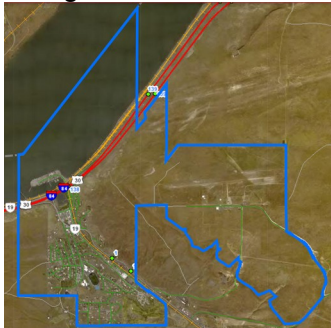
Who is eligible?

- Individuals, community organizations, businesses and local nonprofit organizations.
- Property owners and Renters
- Applicants must be over the age of 18
- All projects must take place within 3 miles of Arlington's City Center (City Hall, 500 W 1st St, Arlington, OR 97812). Google maps will be used to check distances.

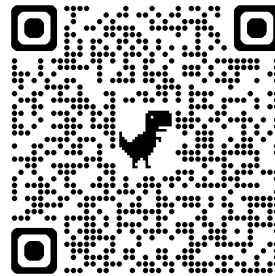
How to apply:

The application period is open January 1, 2026, to February 28, 2026. Paper applications are available at City Hall, or you can apply online by scanning the QR code below with your smartphone. If you received a microgrant in 2024 or 2025, you will automatically be deducted 10 points in the scoring process to allow for new applicants.
