Public Comments* - Wade Streeter called Clerk, Dawn Pingel, about putting a treehouse on his property. He would like to have information on if he would need to have a building permit or setbacks. and he was referred to talk to Alison Elliott, Monroe County Zoning.

Financial Report – Clerk, Dawn Pingel, went over the Town's financial report. Board thanked her.

Pay Bills – Motion to approve to pay bills by Travis Woods, 2nd by Chris Chambers

Monthly Patrolman's Report – Discuss & possible action if needed – Patrolman, Todd Nevin, had the septic pumped, and snow fence is almost all down. The truck bed was taken over to Hanson who gave a quote of \$600 at most – board approved. The recall was taken care of. Kyle Gibbens of Gerke gave a quote of \$385/400 a load for recycled asphalt for road repair. Todd thought six (6) loads would be enough if the board was ok with it. Martins called about sand hauling \$220/225 a load, which is the same as last year. Salt has been ordered to be delivered that was ordered from Mortan salt last fall. Todd Nevin went with Kevin from Scotts Construction over the roads the board was looking at fixing to get an idea of what will be needed.

Monthly Clerk's Report – Discuss & possible action if needed: Clerk, Dawn Pingel, stated that some monthly bills fall outside of when the meetings are and bills come in later with a due date prior to the next month's meeting. Dawn Pingel asked the board about being able to make online monthly bill pay an option, since most of them are for utilities. Motion by Chris Chambers and 2nd by Travis Woods to do an online payment for the utility bills. Clifton Larson Allen Audit is complete and waiting review and a draft will be sent once done.

Discuss & possible action on Temporary Supervisor 1 Appointment – Chad Schuller, Jed Warsaw and Gary Pingel have shown interest in temporarily filling in. As of the

meeting, no interested party came to the meeting and only Chad Schuller had talked with a board member. A job description will be sent out to Chad Schuller to see if he would still be interested. The board will wait for May meeting to discuss further.
