A separate permit may be required by Cass County and by the State of North Dakota for excavation of county or state property and is not assumed in the City of Mapleton permit.

Excavator's Registration. No person, firm or corporation shall engage in the practice of Excavation within the public right-of-way unless registered as an Excavator in the City of Mapleton or under contract with the city.

Registration fee may be set by the City of Mapleton.

Insurance. Proof of liability insurance must be on file with the City Auditor of the City Mapleton in the amount of \$2,000,000. And must name the city as an additional insured as to whom the coverages required are in full force and applicable and for whom defense will be provided as to all such coverages. The City Auditor must be notified 30 days in advance of cancellation of the policy or material modifications of a coverage term. See section 2-0302.

Permit to Excavate. This permit will only be issued to a registered Excavator, to a governmental unit of the city, contractor performing work under a written contract with any governmental unit, or to the owner of a utility franchised to operate within the corporate limits of the City of Mapleton. Application must be submitted 24 hours prior on forms provided by the city. The permit is to be maintained on the site. The City of Mapleton may impose reasonable conditions upon issuance and performance of the applicant to protect the health, safety, and welfare or when necessary to protect the right-of-way and its current use. The permit date may not be extended unless a supplement to the application is submitted prior to expiration, a new permit or permit extension is granted. See section 2-0303

Exemptions. See section 2-304.

Performance Deposits. Deposits as required shall be cash, a certificate of deposit, or a surety bond as approved by the City Attorney. See section 2-0305.

Pre-Excavation requirements. It shall be the responsibility of the permittee to notify all utility companies of the intended excavation. See section 2-0306. ND One Call 800-795-0555.

Warranty. Permittee warrants that restoration work will meet the requirements of the Mapleton City Ordinances for a period of 24 months following the completion of the work. See section 2-0307.
