

## Village of Weyerhaeuser Meeting Minutes

January 14, 2026

The Village of Weyerhaeuser Monthly Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by President Erv Murry.

Present were President Erv Murry, Trustee Don Szozda, Trustee Sandy Arts, and DPW Brian Beckel. Clerk Kopacz was absent. Others Present: Diane Scott

There was no public comment.

There was no Finance report.

Motion to approve December Meeting was made by Don and seconded by Sandy. Motion carried.

The board discussed the grant that was applied for to improve alleys 1, 2, 3 and 4 on the south side of the village. The village was not awarded any loan forgiveness, but only a low interest loan at 1.85% that could be adjusted quarterly. The board agreed that it would not be in the best interest of the residents to burden them with a long-term debt. Along with Brian, they determined that there were other ways improvements could be made to the water system that are more affordable. Brian stated that the water lines could be relined and could be done in sections. This would prevent the alleys from being torn up and replaced. Brian will get pricing per foot to reline. The board is hoping that the savings will be able to be allocated to the repainting of the water tower, which will need to be done within the next couple of years. The village will be looking to see if TIF money can be applied to painting the water tower.

Brian stated that WE Energies wanted to remove the gas lines from the alleys to the streets. They were wanting to start the 3<sup>rd</sup> week in January, but Brian was not in favor and will ask that, if they continue with the plan, they wait until Spring. He is not satisfied with previous repairs and will request professional contractors do the repairs.

Brian discussed the hydraulic issues with the loader. He said they are unable to run the snowblower at this time.

The Methodist Church will donate \$500 a year to the village if they are willing to clear the parking lot of snow. It will not be done until all village streets are cleared.

Motion to plow the Methodist Church parking lot was made by Don and seconded by Sandy. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Don and seconded by Sandy. Motion carried.
