ROY AND JAMES ADVISED MERIT RAISES COULD ADDRESS DIFFERENCES IN PAY BUT ACROSS THE BOARD THE COST OF LIVING HAS INCREASED, SO ALL EMPLOYEES SHOULD GET A COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE IN PAY. THE BOARD DISCUSSED PERCENTAGES VS AMOUNTS. DON DIDIER ADVISED SOCIAL SECURITY GIVES A 2.8% RAISE THIS YEAR. HE STATES HE FEEL THIS IS AN APPROPRIATE AMOUNT. CINDY STATES SHE FEELS SHE IS MORE COMFORTABLE AT 2.5%.

THERE WAS TALK OF THE BEIGE BACKGROUND CLASHING WITH THE BUILDING. JOHN ADVISED HE WILL GET A MOCK UP OF IT WITH WHITE BACKGROUND SINCE THE BUILDING IS GRAY. THE COST OF THE SIGN IS \$398. AMANDA GOLDSMITH PRESENTED SEVERAL AREA

COMMUNITY CENTERS WITH THEIR AMENITIES' AND WHAT THEY CHARGE. IT WAS PROPOSED THAT \$100 PLUS \$50 DEPOSIT (REFUNDABLE) FOR A 4 HOUR BLOCK OF TIME. EACH ADDITIONAL HOUR IS \$25. THERE WAS A PROPOSED RENTAL AGREEMENT THAT NEEDS TO BE LOOKED OVER BY THE CITY ATTORNEY. THE COUNCIL WANTED TO KNOW IF ALCOHOL CAN BE PERMITTED ON CITY PROPERTY. WE WILL ABIDE BY WHAT THE LAW STATES ON THIS MATTER.
