Ordinance 2025-16 "AMENDING ORDINANCE 313.11 DESIGNATION OF STOP STREETS" was read. A MOTION was made by Mr. Spriggs, seconded by Mr. Brower to adopt Ordinance 2025-16 on 3rd reading Final reading. Motion Carried. 6-0

Ordinance 2026-01 "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE RATES FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WEST LIBERTY, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO, AND PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF, BILLING MONTHLY" was read. A MOTION was made by Mr. Spriggs seconded by Mrs. Griffith to pass Ordinance 2026-01 on 1st reading only. Motion Carried. 6-0. This is a 3% increase for rates and per 1000 gallons.

Ordinance 2026-02 "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE RATES FOR GARBAGE/RUBBISH PICK UP SERVICE AND CURBSIDE RECYCLING SERVICE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WEST LIBERTY, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO AND PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF, BILLING MONTHLY" was read. A MOTION was made by Mr. Brower seconded by Mrs. Markin to pass on 1st reading only. Motion Carried. 6-0. This is a 3% increase for trash rates only.

Resolution 2026-R1 "Establishing an Unclaimed Money Fund" was read. A MOTION was made by Mr. Brower, seconded by Mrs. Griffith to waive the rule requiring three separate readings. Motion Carried. A MOTION was made by Mr. Brower seconded by Ms. Markin to adopt Resolution 2026-R1 on first and final reading. Motion Carried. 6-0

Resolution 2026-R2 "Establishing a fund for Training Reimbursements for Police" was read. A MOTION was made by Mrs. Griffith seconded by Mr. Spriggs to waive the rule requiring three separate readings. Motion Carried. A MOTION was made by Mrs. Griffith seconded by Ms. Markin to adopt Resolution 2026-R2 on first and final reading. Motion Carried. 6-0

Park Board Committee Report Mr. Spriggs gave all council members recommended expenditures plan for 2026 approved by the park board. A MOTION was made by Mrs. Griffith seconded by Ms. Markin to approve the expenditures as submitted. Motion Carried.

Mrs. Griffith gave a report for Macochee Joint Ambulance. They have had 1107 runs, 29 in mutual aid and 100 out for mutual aid. They had 782 runs in 2024. They are still looking for a Chief.

Fair View Cemetery had 34 Burials and 32 lots sold .

Administrator Ford needs approval to apply for EPA grant for a Salt Bin. St. Paris received this grant last year for \$75K. A MOTION was made by Mrs. Griffith seconded by Ms. Markin to apply for the salt bin. Motion Carried. 6-0

The two pumps and electric \$30K-\$40K near Green Hills. We have not received a quote yet.

Charging Station Grant was applied for but no other updates.

Administrator Ford said we want to switch Internet and phone service to Spectrum from CT Communications. We will be getting a government price for internet, plus, instead of 10 MB we will get 500 MB. A MOTION was made by Mr. Spriggs, seconded by Ms. Markin to switch. Motion Carried.

We have a quote for the gutter at the library above friendship alley from Jeremiah Seamless. This needs done since we are turning the alley into an activity area. The cost will be \$2,500. He also gave a quote for \$1,500 to repair the Town Hall gutters. A MOTION was made by Mr. Spriggs, seconded Mr. Brower to approve Jeremiah Seamless to repair/replace the gutters. Motion Carried.

The Water Department received quotes for a new Well house and electric at Lions Park from Levi Reed and Rabenstein Electric.
