### **Instructions to Voters:**

**INSTRUCTIONS** 1. To vote you must darken the oval completely. 2. Use a blue or black ball point pen only.

**NOTICE** If you tear, deface, or make a mistake and wrongfully mark any ballot, you must return it to the election board and receive a new ballot. To vote for a candidate, darken the oval to the left of the person's name. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write that person's name in the blank space provided for such purpose and darken the oval to the left.
