SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
Thursday, September 18, 2025

A Special Council Meeting was held on Thursday, September 18, 2025, at the Woodville Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 6:31 PM.

Upon Roll Call, Mayor Steve Helms, Mayor Pro-Tem Darin Geiger, Councilman David Meeks, Councilwoman Melanie Allen, and Councilman James Wallace were present. Councilman James Rau was absent.

Mayor Helms opened the meeting with a prayer and then led the pledge of allegiance.

Councilman David Meeks made a motion to adopt the Agenda, Councilwoman Melanie Allen seconded the motion, the motion carried with a vote of 4 to 0.

Councilman David Meeks made a motion to abolish the decision regarding removing one police officer from the police force due to increase in AMIC Insurance, and keep all four officers employed. Councilwoman Melanie Allen seconded the motion, motion carried with a vote of 4 to 0.

The Sewer was discussed and the council appointed Councilman Rau to be the spokesperson for the Council in contacting Mr. Hastings and requesting a proposal with the intent to come on board with the Town of Woodville as a contract worker, and as the Town of Woodville's Certified Wastewater Operator; (how many hours can Mr. Hastings work, what kind of training he can provide, what other services, reports, etc. can he provide).

Councilman David Meeks made a motion to adjourn. Councilwoman Melanie Allen seconded the motion, the motion was carried with unanimous vote 4 to 0.
