Month Meeting Minutes – motion to approve the March meeting minutes by Travis 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chad

Financial Report – Dawn gave the town's financial report and the board thanked her.

Pay Bills – motion to approve the April bills by Travis 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chad

**Monthly Patrolman's Report** – Discuss & possible action if needed – Todd stated there have been more washouts from the rain on Kiln, along with Kettle. For the washouts, looking to put gravel in to repair them. Jason of Kendall Trucking, thinks the bridge cleanouts can be done with a skid steer, and looking to that on Wednesday, weather pending. The Kettle bridge has a lot of silt, with Lily and Livingstone being the other bridges getting cleaned out. Hoping to get the rest of the snow fence down next week.

**Monthly Clerk's Report** – Discuss & possible action if needed – reminder that the town's spring clean up days are April 10 and 11<sup>th</sup>, and the Monroe County Landfill Hazardous Collection Event is April 11<sup>th</sup>. Dawn will be attending the Spring Clerk Workshop on April 28<sup>th</sup> in Tomah. Everything is set for election.

**Discuss & possible action on Interior Road** – Town of Tomah bridge replacement: Attending for the Interior Road were: Town of Tomah Chair, Todd Sparks, Scotts Construction, Kevin Schmidt – Kevin went over the quote that he was asked to provide by DOT, Joe Stange. Todd Sparks was asked when the completion date was and it was scheduled for mid-May, but the date has not been adjusted to account for the Town of Wilton's side of Interior Road issues. Todd Sparks stated that Gerke has been out a couple of times (possibly 3-4 times) to repair the spots that were the worst. The town board asked Todd Sparks about the projects issues with why the project stopped, and was stated it was because of Wilton's side of Interior. Chad stated he is not comfortable with putting pen to paper until we absolutely know who is the one signing, especially

since no rep was here from Radke. Todd Sparks stated that nothing has been said from Radke, and the DOT was the one saying a meeting should be done with Radke and Town of Wilton. Todd Sparks asked the board if there has been any contact from anyone regarding getting a permit, and no contact had been made.

The Town of Wilton Board decided that we need to be reached out to if anything is going to happen. Todd Sparks will talk with Joe Stange in the morning.

**Discuss & possible action on Road Tour** – roads to be repaired – Kevin from Scotts Construction, answered Chad's questions about the process when gravel is not part of what they do. Discussion followed on town roads from the road tour. As for Interior Road, possibly wait one winter to let things settle before doing anything concrete. Town Board went over the list provided by Kevin and decided to do all the roads listed except Lincoln Ave. Kevin will redo the quote and get a copy to Dawn who then can sign and get back to him.

**Discuss & possible action on opening Cemetery Mowing Bid(s)** – only one bid was submitted from New View Landscaping – motion to accept by Travis, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chad
