AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEW CARROLLTON AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026, AS EMBODIED IN ORDINANCE 25-16, TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN SALARY LINE ITEMS FOR THE CITY MANAGER AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of New Carrollton (the "City Council"), a body politic and corporate of the State of Maryland, is authorized to adopt a fiscal year budget pursuant to City Charter §C-14, "Budget and Finance"; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2026 budget was adopted via Ordinance No. 25-16; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Fiscal Year 2026 budget established authorized salary levels for City positions, including the City Manager and Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to adoption of the budget, compensation levels were offered for the positions of City Manager and Director of Public Works at amounts exceeding those authorized in the adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, expenditures in excess of adopted appropriations require an amendment to the budget in accordance with the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has requested that the City Council consider legislation to amend the Fiscal Year 2026 budget to increase appropriations within the applicable personnel line items to align with such compensation levels; and

Section 1. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of New Carrollton, that Ordinance 25-16, Current Expense Budget for the City of New Carrollton, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2026, under the heading of "City of New Carrollton FY 2026 Adopted Budget" be and hereby is amended as follows:

Budget Amendment Reconciliation No. Eight:
To Amend Ordinance 25-16
Current Expense Budget for FY 2026

Effective: XX, 2026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEW CARROLLTON AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026, AS EMBODIED IN ORDINANCE 25-16, TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE MD TWO FIFTY INITIATIVE, FOOD FOREST PROJECT, AND INVASIVE SPECIES AND TREE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of New Carrollton (the "City Council"), a body politic and corporate of the State of Maryland, is authorized to adopt a fiscal year budget pursuant to City Charter §C-14, "Budget and Finance"; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2026 budget was adopted via Ordinance No. 25-16; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Fiscal Year 2026 budget did not include sufficient appropriations to fully proceed with and complete certain environmental, educational, and community-based initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to proceed with and complete the MD Two Fifty Initiative, Food Forest Project, and Invasive Species and Tree Management Program; and

WHEREAS, the MD Two Fifty Initiative includes the launch of the New Carrollton Intergenerational Citizen Academy, a three-month civic learning program designed to inspire and equip residents of all ages to better understand, participate in, and engage with local government; and

WHEREAS, the Food Forest Project, supported by grant funding, will establish a diverse range of food-bearing trees, shrubs, and plants at Veterans Park, providing year-round access to fresh produce, promoting environmental sustainability, and encouraging community involvement; and

WHEREAS, the Invasive Species and Tree Management Program will enable the City to implement a revised project scope that expands invasive species management, tree preservation, and ecological restoration efforts across six municipal parks; and

WHEREAS, expenditures in excess of adopted appropriations require an amendment to the budget in accordance with the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has requested that the City Council consider legislation to amend the Fiscal Year 2026 budget to increase appropriations to support these initiatives and ensure their successful implementation;

Section 1. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of New Carrollton, that Ordinance 25-16, Current Expense Budget for the City of New Carrollton, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2026, under the heading of "City of New Carrollton FY 2026 Adopted Budget" be and hereby is amended as follows:

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of New Carrollton, Maryland, with at least four-fifth of the total Council concurring, that this Ordinance be deemed an emergency ordinance so that it shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor or when passed over his veto by the City Council.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEW CARROLLTON AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026, AS EMBODIED IN ORDINANCE 25-16, TO REALLOCATE AND TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS AMONG VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND LINE ITEMS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of New Carrollton (the "City Council"), a body politic and corporate of the State of Maryland, is authorized to adopt a fiscal year budget pursuant to City Charter §C-14, "Budget and Finance"; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2026 budget was adopted via Ordinance No. 25-16; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to adjust budgeted appropriations to reflect changing operational needs, project priorities, and expenditure patterns; and

WHEREAS, certain departments and programs require additional funding, while others have available balances that may be reallocated without adversely affecting service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget amendments will transfer and reallocate funds among various departments and line items to ensure the efficient and effective use of City resources; and

WHEREAS, such reallocations do not increase the total adopted budget but instead redistribute existing appropriations; and

WHEREAS, expenditures in excess of adopted appropriations or transfers between categories require an amendment to the budget in accordance with the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has requested that the City Council consider legislation to authorize these budget adjustments;

Section 1. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of New Carrollton, that Ordinance 25-16, Current Expense Budget for the City of New Carrollton, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2026, under the heading of "City of New Carrollton FY 2026 Adopted Budget" be and hereby is amended as follows:
