II. Discharge Requirements

A. Designated Discharge Points:

1. The Hauler shall discharge the trucked waste at the following designated facility:
Westerly Wastewater Treatment Facility.

2. Discharge of trucked waste shall not commence without first weighing and properly executing the Waste Tracking Record. The tracking records will be signed by the hauler and a Wastewater Division representative. Any discharge occurring prior to a representative being notified, not leaving a tracking record, or making other arrangements with the Environmental Services Manager will void this permit.

B. Waste Tracking Record:

1. The Hauler will use the current form of the tracking record provided at the facility. The Hauler will record every load that is pumped into the tank truck and delivered to either treatment facility.

2. Failure to accurately record every load, facility or data, or failure to transmit the form to the Altoona Water Authority representative prior to discharging will constitute a violation of this permit resulting in revocation of the permit or a fine not less than one-thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per violation.

C. Sampling of Waste Delivered:

1. Prior to the discharge of any holding tank, septic, sludge, or permitted industrial wastewater the hauler will provide a sample of the waste in the bottles provided by the Altoona Water Authority or as directed by the Environmental Services Manager. These samples will be taken to Pace Analytical Services for analysis to ensure compliance with the current local limits and DEP requirements.
2. The Hauler may be required to suspend the discharging of the waste until the analysis is completed. The Wastewater Division reserves the right to refuse any trucked waste that is suspected of being incompatibly or is so determined through the sampling and analysis.
3. The Hauler is prohibited from discharging waste which exceeds the local limits specified in the Altoona Water Authority's Rules and Regulations.

D. Fees:

1. The Hauler will pay the sum of two-hundred dollars (\$200.00) for a two (2) year permit to discharge at the wastewater treatment facilities.
 - a. The Hauler will provide, on a separate typewritten sheet, the following information:

1. Registrations numbers for each vehicle to be used for deliveries
2. License plate numbers for each vehicle
3. Color, make, and model of each vehicle
4. Permit numbers and expiration dates of all other permits (DEP, Blair County, etc.)

- b. The Hauler will notify the Environmental Services Manager in writing of any additional, replacement, or diminished fleet size or any new permits received after this issuance of this permit. Notification of equipment changes will be submitted fifteen (15) days prior to utilizing the new equipment to discharge at the Altoona Water Authority.
2. The Hauler shall be required to pay for all sampling and analysis as well as any surcharges levied under the Altoona Water Authority's Rules and Regulations.
3. The Hauler shall also pay the current user charge rate as specified in the Altoona Water Authority's Rules and Regulations unless prohibited by the inter-municipal agreements.

E. Discharge:

1. The Hauler is prohibited from discharging wastes with characteristics specified under the Altoona Water Authority's Rules and Regulations.

F. Liability Insurance:

1. The Hauler shall indemnify and hold harmless the Altoona Water Authority from all claims, suits, or actions arising from the use by the Hauler of said property, and shall procure and maintain good and sufficient liability insurance of \$300,000.00 per person injured and \$500,000.00 for each occurrence.
2. The Hauler will attach a copy of the insurance coverage to this application prior to submission unless other arrangements were approved by the Environmental Services Manager.

G. Permit Revocation:

1. Revocation will be determined by the Environmental Services Manager for the Altoona Water Authority.

III. Approval Statement (completed by AWA official)
