

Grafton City Council Proceedings
November 10, 2025

Mayor John W. Bork convened the regular meeting of the Grafton City Council at 7 PM, November 10, 2025 at Grafton City Hall. Answering roll call were Dalluge, Fossey, Hulshizer, Kruger, and Schaub. Visitors were Bruce White and Mark Borchardt. Kruger motioned, 2nd by Hulshizer to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Fossey motioned, 2nd by Dalluge to approve the minutes from the October 13, 2025 meeting. Motion carried.

Mark Borchardt talked to the council about the water problem in his basement. After some discussion, he then left at 7:20 PM.

Clerk presented the financial reports, past due utility accounts, and bills to be paid. Fossey motioned, 2nd by Dalluge to approve the financial reports as presented and pay all bills due to date. Motion carried.

Kruger motioned, 2nd by Schaub to approve the building permit from Cole Feldt for a composite deck on his property at 405 2nd Street. Motion carried.

Resolution #2025-14 to certify a lien against real estate at 309 3rd Street was reviewed. Schaub motioned, 2nd by Kruger to approve the resolution. Upon roll call vote, all council members voted aye. Resolution #2025-14 is passed and approved. Resolution #2025-15 to certify a lien against real estate at 305 3rd Street was reviewed. Dalluge motioned, 2nd by Kruger to approve the resolution. Upon roll call vote, all council members voted aye. Resolution #2025-15 is passed and approved. The clerk will file the liens with the Worth County Treasurer.

There was no old business. Under new business, grants were discussed. There being no further business, Fossey motioned, 2nd by Kruger for adjournment. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 8:07 PM.
