7. **HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BOARD MEETING**

You can participate in the meeting in a number of ways:

Open Forum is an opportunity for the public to speak regarding items not listed on the agenda. Speakers are limited to a maximum of 3 minutes per person. To address the Library Board of Trustees, you must submit a speaker card to the liaison prior to the start of that item. You should be aware that the Library Board of Trustees is prohibited by State law from taking action on any items that are not listed on the agenda. However, if your item requires action, the Board may place it on a future agenda or direct staff to work with you and/or report to the Board on the issue.

Other Agenda Items are also open for public input including Consent Calendar or Matters for Consideration items. These comments are also subject to the 3-minute limit.

Special Meetings, Workshops - The public will have the opportunity to address the Library Board of Trustees regarding the item that is the subject of the special meeting or workshop. Public comments are limited to a maximum of 3 minutes per person.

Submission of Comments Prior to the Meeting:

Email Comments may be submitted by the public to the Board liaison (LibBoardPubComments@livermoreca.gov). Items received no later than 12:00 pm on the day of the meeting will be provided to the Library Board of Trustees and available on the City website prior to the meeting. These items will NOT be read into the record.

eComments may be submitted by the public using the eComment link [here](#). Comments may be up to 1000 characters in length and will be accepted up until 6:00 pm the day of the meeting. These items will NOT be read into the record and are viewable by the Library Board of Trustees and the public upon submittal.

Submission of Comments During the Meeting:

Speakers are limited to a maximum of 3 minutes per person. To submit a comment, you must complete a speaker card for each item. Speaker cards are available in the Civic Center Meeting Hall lobby. Indicate on the card the item number you wish to comment on and submit the card directly to the liaison prior to the start of the item. You should be aware that the Board is prohibited by State law from taking action on any items that are not listed on the agenda. However, if your item requires action, the Board may place it on a future agenda or direct staff to work with you and/or report to the Board on the issue.

If you would like to deliver written materials to the Library Board of Trustees as part of your public comments, please provide 8 copies to the liaison with your speaker card.

The **Library Board of Trustees Agenda and Agenda Reports** are prepared by City staff and are available for public review a minimum of 72 hours prior to the meeting at the 1016 South Livermore Avenue, Livermore. The Agenda is also available on the City's website, <http://livermoreca.gov/agenda>.
