

Grafton City Council Proceedings  
September 10, 2025

Mayor Pro Tem Tom Kruger convened the regular meeting of the Grafton City Council at 7 PM, September 10, 2025 at Grafton City Hall. Answering roll call were Dalluge, Fossey, Hulshizer, and Schaub. Visitor was Bruce White. Fossey motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Schaub to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Hulshizer motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dalluge to approve the minutes from the August 11, 2025 meeting. Motion carried.

Clerk presented the financial reports, past due utility accounts, and bills to be paid. Schaub motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Fossey to approve the financial reports as presented and pay all bills due to date. Motion carried.

The annual City Street Finance Report (Resolution #2025-12) was presented by the clerk. Schaub motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dalluge to approve the report. Upon roll call vote, all council members voted aye. Resolution #2025-12 is passed and approved. The clerk will file the report with the Iowa Department of Transportation.

Under old business, tree removal and the brush pile were discussed.

Under new business, the clerk reminded the council that nomination papers for the city election must be received by Thursday, September 18, 2025 at 5 PM. There was also a request from Mark & Tiffany Ganrude to allow chickens on their property at 309 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Fossey motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Schaub to allow them up to 6 chickens. Roosters are not allowed, and they must stay in their fenced property. Motion carried. Fossey motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hulshizer to set Trick and Treat night for Sunday, October 26<sup>th</sup> from 5 to 7 PM this year. Motion carried. There being no further business, Dalluge motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hulshizer for adjournment. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 7:44 PM.
