

# Receive up to \$500 to help with reducing your wildfire risk!



## Wildland Urban Interface Microgrant Program

The City of Arlington has received wildfire hazard mitigation funding from the Oregon State Fire Marshal to assist landowners and residents in the City of Arlington with reducing wildfire risk to their homes. This is the final year that residents and property owners within 3 miles of the City Center (City Hall, 500 W 1<sup>st</sup> St, Arlington, OR 97812) can apply for up to \$500 of funding to assist with wildfire mitigation projects.

### Projects must fall within these categories:

**Fuel Reduction, Vegetation Management and Defensible Space Enhancement:** Projects that focus on reducing the accumulation of hazardous/flammable vegetation, such as tree trimming, mowing and weed removal. Projects must reduce wildfire risk on private property and can include hiring laborers to complete the work.

**Small Scale Vegetation Management Equipment:** One-time purchase of small equipment, including string trimmers, lawn mowers, clippers, and other vegetation management devices.

The application period is open from January 5, 2026, to February 28, 2026. Paper applications are available at City Hall or apply online by scanning the QR code below with your smartphone!
