THERE WILL BE A BLOOD DRIVE HERE IN THE COURT HOUSE ON MAY 27TH FROM 1300-1800. THERE WERE 5 BIDDERS ON THE FIRE TRAINING BUILDING THAT ATTENDING THE PRE-BID MEETING. ALL RUNNING WELL. DOING GENERAL MAINTENANCE ON TRUCKS.

JOHN LIMBOCKER – HE CALLED FOUR DIFFERENT COMPANIES THAT MAKE PLAQUES FOR THE COMMUNITY CENTER. ONLY ONE GOT BACK WITH HIM. HE CAN GET TWO FOR THE INSIDE MADE IN ABOUT 3 WEEKS, ONE FOR THE THANKS TO THE CHOCTAW NATION AND THE OTHER WITH THE TOWN COUNCIL LISTED AND DEDICATION ON IT. THEY ARE \$71 EACH. IT HAS BEEN MORE DIFFICULT FINDING SOMEONE TO MAKE THE OUTDOOR SIGN BUT HE IS STILL LOOKING. FOR THE GRAND OPENING CNB HAS OFFERED TO COOK HOT DOGS AND HAMBURGERS FOR US. WE DO HAVE MONEY IN OUR BUDGET FROM THE COMMUNITY CENTER LEFT TO FUND THE EVENT.

SEWER PLANT – THERE IS STILL ONE MORE LIFT STATION THAT NEEDS SERVICED. A COMPANY IN ARKANSAS CALLED RTR HAD A CHEMICAL SPILL ON HWY 271S THAT DEQ HAS NOTIFIED US ABOUT. THEY PUT HYDRATED LIME OUT TO CONTROL CONTAMINATION. THE SITUATION IS BEING MONITORED TO MAKE SURE IT IS NOT AFFECTING OUR WATER SUPPLY.

GIS DATA HAS CHANGED WE ARE HAVING TO UPDATE OUR OWN ADDRESSES'. THE STATE 911 COORDINATOR WILL BE HERE 5/6/26. THEY ADVISE IT MIGHT BE BETTER TO CONTRACT OUT THIS UPDATING. WE ARE WANTING TO CHANGE FROM A LIGHT TERMINAL TO A FULL TERMINAL ON OLETS. LEFLORE COUNTY IS WANTING TO CHARGE US \$500 A MONTH TO INPUT DATA. WE CAN GET A FULL TERMINAL ON ONE COMPUTER AND KEEP THE LIGHT TERMINAL ON THE OTHER FOR A TOTAL OF \$450/MONTH. OUR DISPATCHERS WILL NEED MORE TRAINING BUT WE WILL BE ABLE TO DO ALL OUR OWN INPUTTING AND UPDATING.

14. JOE TRUSTY DISCUSSED POSSIBLY PUTTING AN ORDINANCE INTO PLACE FOR NUISANCE/INOP VEHICLES. HE HAS CONSULTED WITH NICK GRANT AND UNDERSTANDS HE CAN GO FORWARD ON THE ABATEMENT PROCESS AS IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH STATE STATUE, BUT WITH THE ORDINANCE IT MAY BE ABLE TO SHORTEN THE WAIT TIME. JOE STATES ROLAND HAS ADMINISTRATION FEES WHEN THEY HAVE TO ABATE - \$300 FOR YARD CLEAN-UP AND \$ 1,000 FOR DILAPIDATED BUILDINGS. JOE WILL GET WITH MARK TO GET A COPY OF THE ORDINANCES AND THE PROCEDURES. NICK GRANT STATES WE CAN DO ABATEMENT AS LONG AS WE FOLLOW THE STATUE. THE PROCEDURE OF DOING IT WILL NOT BE IN STATUE.

18. CINDY JACKSON DISCUSSED HOW THE EMPLOYEES ARE HELD TO A POLICY OF ETHICAL BEHAVIOR THAT HAS FORMS OF DISCIPLINE IF NOT FOLLOWED. SHE STATES ALL TRUSTEES NEED TO FILL OUT A COMPLAIN

FORM IF THEY WANT ANY WORK DONE. DON FEELS THE COUNCIL HAS PRIORITY. CINDY STATED NO EMPLOYEE SHOULD FEAR THEIR JOB FROM A COUNCIL MEMBER. THEY SHOULD BE SPOKEN TO BY THEIR OWN SUPERVISOR. DON THINKS HE IS JUST ADVISING THE EMPLOYEES WHAT CAN HAPPEN IF BEHAVIOR IS NOT CHANGED. CINDY IS WANTING TO ADD THOSE PAGES TO THE COUNCIL HANDBOOK. SHE DIRECTED THE BOARD TO # 14 ABUSIVE, INTIMIDATING, AND/OR THREATENING LANGUAGE OR GESTURES OR ANY TYPE OF BULLYING OR CYBERBULLYING BOTH WHILE ON THE JOB OR VIA SOCIAL MEDIA. AND # 25 SEXUAL, VERBAL, PHYSICAL OR CYBER HARASSMENT. NICK GRANT WAS ASKED ABOUT THIS ISSUE. NICK ADVISED THE COUNCIL IS VERY LIMITING AS TO ANY FORM OF PUNISHMENT THEY CAN IMPOSE ON EACH OTHER. THEY ARE ELECTED AND CAN NOT KICK EACH OTHER OFF THE BOARD. THE ONLY WAY THEY CAN BE REMOVED IS VOTED OUT OR THE DA WOULD HAVE TO BE PETITIONED FOR REMOVAL. HE SAID THAT IS VERY RARE, UNLESS THEY COMMIT A SERIOUS CRIME. LYNDSEE LYONS WANTS TO REMIND EVERYONE WE ARE ALL ADULTS AND ASKS IF WE CAN AGREE THAT THE EMPLOYEES AND TRUSTEES NEED TO FOLLOW THE CHAIN OF COMMAND. EVERYONE AGREED. LYNDSEE GOES ON TO SAY IF THE LEADERSHIP CAN NOT LEAD IT NEEDS TO BE A DISCUSSION IN EXECUTIVE SESSION, NOT OUTSIDE THE COUNCIL AS A WHOLE.

19. ROY WALKER MADE THE MOTION TO LEAVE THE CODE OF ETHICS AS IS WITH THE UNDERSTANDING WE WILL ALL BE PROFESSIONAL AND IF THERE ARE ISSUES IT WILL BE ADDRESSED IN EXECUTIVE SESSION, NOT DIRECTLY WITH THE EMPLOYEES. MOTION SECONDED IT BY CINDY JACKSON.

20. THE TRUSTEES ASKED ABOUT SEARCH FOR ANOTHER STREET EMPLOYEE. JOHN LIMBOCKER ADVISED THERE WERE 4 OLD APPLICATIONS AT THE TOWN HALL. IT WAS DISCUSSED ABOUT SETTING UP A BOOTH AT THE JOB FAIR TO GET NEW CANDIDATES. THE STREET SUPERVISOR NEEDS TO MAKE SURE AND BUDGET FOR THE POSITION IN HIS 2026-2027 BUDGET DUE TO HIS SHORTAGE THIS FY.

21. **CHIEF BARNETT** - APRIL CITATIONS UP 2%, 208 CALLS FOR SERVICE. NEWEST OFFICER DUNCAN IS IN CLEET. SMOKELESS RANGE IS UP AND RUNNING. CHIEF BARNETT INVITED ALL TRUSTEES TO COME AND SEE. HE HAS STARTED A VERY DETAILED INVENTORY AND WILL BE COMPLETED SOON.

LEE BEUTELSCHIES - THEY HAVE STARTED CUTTING GRASS. THEY HAVE ABOUT THREE OR FOUR MORE STREETS BEFORE THAT IS COMPLETELY CLEARED UP. LEE STATES HE BEEN CATCHING UP WITH TICKETS AND COMPLAINTS. HE IS FILLING POTHOLES AND BRUSH HOGGING. ALL HIS EMPLOYEES ARE TAKING VACATION SO HE HAS BEEN SHORT HANDED. THEY FIXED GREGORY STREET 5/4. THE TRUSTEES ASKED IF THE MERRY GO ROUND HAS BEEN INSTALLED. LEE ADVISED IT IS STILL BOXED IN THE SHOP. HE SAID THEY WILL GET TO IT ON A RAINY DAY. HE IS UNSURE IF THEY WILL NEED TO HAVE A CONCRETE SLAB POURED, BUT HE WILL LET US KNOW WHEN HE GETS THE INSTRUCTIONS OUT OF THE BOX.

22. ROY WALKER ADVISED HE WAS TOLD WE ARE ALLOWED TO PUT UP CHRISTMAS DECORATION ON THE LIGHT POLES. THE COUNCIL DISCUSSED HOW THE LIGHT POLES IN TOWN ARE NOT LINED UP AND IT MAY NOT LOOK VERY GOOD. THE TRUSTEES BEGAN DISCUSSING THE PARK AND WHAT IS CONTRACTED TO BE MOWED. JOHN LIMBOCKER ADVISED ONLY THE FRONT HALF IS BUT WE CAN LOOK AT HAVING HIM MOW THE BACK OR HAVE THE CITY MOW AT THE SAME TIME SO IT LOOKS THE SAME.
