Mayor Kelly Routh called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Motion to approve the agenda, minutes from the council meeting on September 9<sup>th</sup>, and the accounts payable was made by Kyle, seconded by Matt; motion carried.

Public Input:

- Freeborn County Crime Victim's Crisis Center (CVCC): Director Maureen presented for their campaign to "Paint the Town Purple" in honor of Domestic Violence month in October. Freeborn Co CVCC served 425 residents in 2023 for assistance with domestic violence situations.
- The new gazebo will be put up the week of October 14<sup>th</sup>. It was suggested that the gazebo should have power for holiday decorating, and the City agrees to move forward with putting in power as in multiple outlets and a low power light.

Fire Dept.:

- No billable calls

City Maintenance:

- The gazebo going up in October.
- A new roof will be put on the community center beginning mid October. Damage due to 2021 tornado.
- Tool Cat: \$34k for a new model with the value of a trade in with \$41k value. The City model is 6 years old with 2400 hours. Matt makes a motion to trade in and purchase new, seconded by Kyle; motion carried.
- Estimates to fix concession stand: \$15k by John Hullopeter while he does community center roof. The job would be to redo the roof. Kyle makes a motion to use John Hullopeter Construction, seconded by Matt; carried.
- Short sidewalk to connect gazebo to nearby sidewalk will be part of the landscaping.
- Multiple letters need to be sent out to remind of City Ordinances regarding: inoperable vehicles and vegetation grooming.

This ordinance will be imposed until further acted upon.
