VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Students applying for this vocational scholarship must be seniors at an area high school within fifty miles of Hugoton, Kansas. A certified high school transcript shall be provided with this application.

A specific GPA is NOT required to apply for the vocational scholarship.

Scholarship funds will be awarded upon successful completion of the student's first semester of full time attendance at a vocational school. Verification of this information (an official transcript OR a letter from school's registrar stating student's status in chosen program) and a copy of the 2nd semester schedule will be required.

The scholarship may be used for educational expenses (books, tuition, and/or housing) in attending any vocational school. Recipients must take courses at the location of the vocational institution of their choice. Questions: Call Mrs. Johnson at 620.482.0439.
