RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS ACCEPTING SANDAG SMART GROWTH INCENTIVE PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS, APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET, APPROPRIATING PROJECT FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENTS AND RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, up to \$45 million of TransNet funding for Smart Growth Incentive Program (SGIP) projects was available to local jurisdictions and the County of San Diego through the SGIP Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos (City) wishes to receive grant funding from the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2025-9425 the City applied for the following three projects for the SGIP grant program:

- a. Capital Improvement Category: San Marcos Boulevard Multi-Modal Corridor Improvements
- b. Planning Category: San Marcos Boulevard Corridor Plan
- c. Climate Action Plan: Update to the San Marcos Climate Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, should a grant award be made by SANDAG to fund one or more of the above referenced projects, as a condition of grant acceptance the City committed to providing the matching fund amounts per project as listed in the grant application; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2025, the SANDAG Board of Directors approved grant awards for the TransNet SGIP Cycle 6 Planning and Climate Action Plan Projects; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2026, the SANDAG Board of Directors approved grant awards for the TransNet SGIP Cycle 6 Capital Projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Marcos as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The City accepts the SANDAG SGIP grant funding for all three of the above referenced projects and commits to providing the matching fund amounts per project as listed in the grant application.
3. The City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-26 Capital Improvement Program Budget to add three new projects and appropriating funding as follows:
 - a. Appropriate up to \$3,970,697.00 to the San Marcos Boulevard Multi-Way Project CIP #ST026;
 - b. Appropriate up to \$920,350.00 to the San Marcos Boulevard Corridor Plan CIP #PL013;
 - c. Appropriate up to \$324,450.00 to the San Marcos Climate Action Plan (CAP) Update CIP #PL014
4. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the SANDAG SGIP grant agreements and related documents.
