

New Vienna City Public Hearing Minutes
April 14, 2026

Mayor Roger Langel opened the Public Hearing on the Amended Budget Adoption for FY2026 at 5:30pm. Present were council members: Kathy Engelken, Caleb Puetz, TJ Kloser, Carly Mausser, Brandon Meyer.

Puetz made the motion to approve the agenda for April 14, 2026 Amended Budget seconded by Kloser. Due to improper publication, we were not able to address this issue today.

Motion from Puetz to close public hearing and open new public hearing, second by Kloser.

Mayor Roger Langel opened the Public Hearing on the Amended Book of Ordinances, Ordinance #2026-02 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, at 5:32pm.

Engelken made the motion to approve the agenda for Public Hearing on April 14, 2026 for Amended Book of Ordinances seconded by Meyer. Ayes-Meyer, Engelken, Puetz, Mausser, Kloser.

Mayor Langel stated there were no comments received written or verbal on the public hearing.

Motion from Engelken to close public hearing and open regular meeting, second by Puetz.

Mayor Roger Langel opened the regular council meeting at 5:40pm.

Puetz made the motion to approve the agenda for the regular council meeting seconded by Kloser.

Mausser made the motion to approve the agenda that consist of bills, financial reports and minutes from March 24th meeting second by Kloser.

Building permit for Jo Ann Ludwig for a fence was approved on a motion from Puetz, second by Engelken.

Ayes-Meyer, Engelken, Puetz, Mausser, Kloser.

Grant application by Wayne Brunsman to paint the top of the water tower was not approved by the council because we have other potential things we want to get paid next year.

Mayor Langel stated that Craig Recker sends an Industrial Addition Phase 2 drawings we will wait till he gets us an official redrawn maybe by the next meeting we could approve a new plot plan for him.

RESOLUTION #09-2026 A RESOLUTION TO APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR FY27 was approved on a motion from Puetz, second by Kloser, Ayes-Meyer, Engelken, Puetz ,Mausser, Kloser.

Motion from Puetz to approve the bid from C&D Construction worth \$5,538.90 submitted by Randy Demmer to replace the City Shop roof. The project must be completed within a month prior to the installation of solar panels. Any additional charges must receive prior approval from the council, second by Meyer. Ayes-Meyer, Engelken, Puetz, Mausser, Kloser.

Motion from Caleb to Adopt the 2026 Amended Book of Ordinances #2026-02 second by Meyer. Ayes-Meyer, Engelken, Puetz, Mausser, Kloser.

Mayor Langel stated that Daniel Pike submitted Water/Sewer monthly report for April 2026, all daily and bacterial sampling is current and the monthly report is complete.

Eli and Marcus Summy were present, Eli Summy discussed plans for lawn mowing and requested that the city hire Marcus Summy and Stephen Yoder as temporary part-time employees to assist as needed with mowing and other maintenance tasks. Following discussion, the council offered a starting wage of \$22.00 per hour for temporary part time position. Motion from Meyer second by Mausser.

Mayor Langel informed the council that he signed all the contracts for the solar panels. It is also stated that the City Wide Clean Up is scheduled for Tuesday, May 12, 2026.

Mayor Langel signed a proclamation declaring the week of **April 26- May 3, 2026**, as a **Stewardship Week** in the City of New Vienna. This year's theme is "**Soil. Where it All Begins,**" which emphasizes the importance of preserving and restoring the soil as part of our collective conservation efforts.
