NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Gentlemen:

Etowah County is taking bids for labor, equipment, materials, and any incidentals required to complete the work of the following items required for the "In-Place Plant Mix" work of the County. This bid is intended to comply with the Rebuild Alabama Act, Act No. 2019-2, as amended, and the Alabama Public Works Law, Alabama Code Title 39, as amended. Bidders shall be required to comply with the provisions of the Rebuild Alabama Act, Act No. 2019-2, as amended and the Alabama Public Works Law, Alabama Code Title 39, as amended, regardless if the requirement is explicitly detailed in the bid proposal or not. This bid shall be in effect from February 1st, 2026 until January 31st, 2027 covering any Proceed Orders issued by Etowah County during that time frame.

Sealed bids will be received by the Etowah County Commission at 800 Forrest Avenue, Gadsden, Al 35901 until 10:00 AM Central Time on January 21st, 2026, and then publicly opened as soon thereafter as practicable. Award will be made at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Etowah County Commission. Only bids from contractors or material suppliers listed on the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) approved list of contractors and material suppliers will be accepted. All bids must be marked with the word "BID" on the outside of the bid package along with Bid Proposal for "In-Place Plant Mix", the bid date and the Alabama General Contractor's License Number.

The contractor shall meet all Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) Bonding and Licensing requirements as well as all applicable laws, ordinances, and codes of the U. S. Government, the State of Alabama, any relevant municipality, and the COUNTY, and, specifically and without limitation, shall comply with all provisions of the Beason-Hammond Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, commonly referred to as the Immigration Act.

All bid items shall be placed in accordance with the bid items and specifications, current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications (non-metric edition), and any Supplemental Specifications approved by the Etowah County Engineer. This project is being advertised, let to contract, and administered by an awarding authority other than the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT). All references made in the standard specifications and in other related and included documents of this proposal, to ALDOT (except as applies to references made to ALDOT considering a bidder to be disqualified from bidding, or to the awarding authority consulting or interacting with ALDOT, etc.), the "State", the "Department" or "Highway Department", etc. shall be understood to mean the awarding authority for this project.

Should the bidder desire to offer a substitute for any item listed in this proposal, a full description of the item(s) offered as substitutes shall be submitted to the County Engineer at least 48 hours before the time stated for opening the bids. The County Engineer will issue an addendum, if necessary, to all bidders who have obtained a bid proposal. Each bidder shall include a copy of the addendum with his/her signature indicating they had received the addendum when submitting their bid. If no addendum is issued, the substitute will not be considered in determining the lowest responsible bidder. No bid proposals or additional addenda will be issued 24 hours prior to the time of the bid opening. Etowah County reserves the right to potentially utilize multiple bids if found to be beneficial to Etowah County.

Signature on bid must be in ink. Bids made out in pencil will NOT be accepted. Etowah County reserves the right to accept or reject all Bids or any portion thereof. Etowah County Hours of Operation are 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. (Central Time) from Monday through Friday. BID PROPOSAL FOR **"In-Place Plant Mix"**

To the Etowah County Commission:

The undersigned shall give Etowah County at least 48 hours' notice in advance of performing work at any site once a Proceed Order has been issued by Etowah County. The undersigned must receive written permission to work on Saturdays, Sundays, or County recognized holidays 48 hours prior to such work commencing. Unless otherwise directed in writing by the County Engineer, the undersigned will be expected to begin work within 15 calendar days after issuance of the Proceed Order. The undersigned will be given a minimum of Fifteen (15) Calendar Days as defined in the current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, per Proceed Order. Each Proceed Order shall designate the amount of working days or calendar days allowed. Should the undersigned fail to complete the project or projects specified in the Proceed Order within the working days or calendar days stipulated, liquidated damages shall be assessed as defined in section 108.10 in the current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications or as amended by Special Provision.

A certified check, drawn on an Alabama Bank, or bid bond, for \$10,000 made payable to the Etowah County Commission is enclosed as evidence of good faith. Within 15 days upon notification of bid award, the undersigned shall submit a Performance Bond for 100% of estimated cost for each Proceed Order and a Payment Bond for 50% of estimated cost for each Proceed Order to Etowah County along with the contract documents, certificate of public liability insurance, certificate of proof of workman's compensation insurance, and business license. The undersigned shall provide to the County his/her Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) Vendor Identification Number as shown on the E-Verify Compliance Status List on the ALDOT website as proof of enrollment in E-Verify.

The undersigned shall submit the Advertisement of Project Completion to Etowah County immediately following the completion and acceptance of all work required, per Proceed Order. The County Engineer will submit the advertisement to the Association of County Commissions of Alabama (ACCA) to be posted on a website maintained by ACCA for a period of four consecutive weeks.

Upon completion and acceptance of all work required, the undersigned will be paid upon presentation of the following:

- a. A properly executed and duly certified voucher for final payment.
- b. A release of all claims and claims of liens against the awarding authority arising by virtue of the contract.
- c. Proof of Advertisement of project completion (AL Code 39-1-1(f) requires a 30 day waiting period after the notice has run before final settlement can be made)

The undersigned agrees: **Final payment will be made within 35 days after all the above requirements are met; Partial Payments, to be paid no more than monthly, for each Proceed Order will be provided under this contract; Retainage shall be withheld on each Proceed Order as required under Code of Alabama Section 39-2-12.**

By submitting this proposal, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate the federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor, at its sole expense, shall obtain and maintain in full force the following insurance to protect the Contractor and the County Commission of Etowah County, Alabama (CCEC) at limits and coverages specified below. These limits and coverages specified are the minimum to be maintained and are not intended to represent the correct insurance needed to fully and adequately protect the Contractor

All insurance will be provided by insurers licensed to conduct business in the State of Alabama and shall have a minimum A.M. Best rating of A- VII and must be acceptable to the CCEC. Self-insured plans and/or group funds not having an A.M. Best rating must be submitted to the CCEC for prior approval.

No work shall be performed until proof of compliance with the insurance requirements has been received by the CCEC.

The Additional Insured form MUST include the current Operations and Products/Completed Operations of the contractor. The naming of the additional insured does not obligate the additional insured to pay any premiums due.

- Aggregate limits to be on a “per project” basis OR an Owners and Contractors Protective Liability Policy shall be provided in the name of CCEC, the contractor and Subcontractors. Limits to be the same as above Commercial General Liability.

(c) Automobile Liability

Covering all Owned, Non-Owned, and Hired vehicles with a Combined single limit (bodily injury and property damage combined) of \$3,000,000 each accident. The policy shall name CCEC its officers, appointees, employees, and agents as an Additional Insured.

(d) Protection and Indemnity Insurance

If the contract involves work aboard an Owned, Non-Owned or Hired Vessel, Liability coverage in the amount of \$3,000,000 per occurrence shall be maintained.

(d) Indemnification and Liability

Under this section the term County shall include Etowah County, the Etowah County Commission, the officers, appointees, department heads, agents, and employees of the Etowah County Commission

The County shall not be liable for any injury to the person or property of any person, firm, or corporation resulting directly or indirectly from Contractor’s performance of this Contract, and the Contractor assumes full and complete responsibility therefore.

The Contractor shall further indemnify the County and hold the County safe and harmless from any and all liability, lawsuits, judgments, attorney fees, and other costs incurred by the County in defending any claim or lawsuit made against the County by any person, firm, or corporation arising directly or indirectly out of the Contractor’s work performed pursuant to this contract or any breach or alleged breach of duty or responsibility of the Contractor under the scope of this contract; the Contractor shall not be responsible for indemnifying the County for claims arising from the engineering or design decisions of the County or claims that are unrelated to the scope of the Contractor’s work.

Certificate of Insurance

A Certificate of Insurance evidencing the above minimum requirements must be provided to and accepted by the CCEC PRIOR to commencement of any work on the contract. Each policy shall be endorsed by the issuing insurer to provide thirty (30) days prior written notice of cancellation to the CCEC.

BID ITEMS AND SPECIFICATIONS

WORK DESCRIPTION: Work shall consist of any items listed in this Invitation to Bid to be performed at various locations in Etowah County as required by the County Engineer. The successful bidder must also furnish all traffic control devices during construction as directed by the engineer and according to the MUTCD. Item 405-A Tack Coat shall be included in the bid price of the Asphalt Plant mix. The successful bidder will be responsible for ordering the bituminous plant mix as needed according to the pounds per square yard on roads or as directed by the County Engineer or his representative.

It shall be the bidder's responsibility to possess all proper County, State, and Federal license and to familiarize himself with and shall comply with all Federal, State, and Local laws, ordinances, and regulations.

Materials and construction requirements shall meet the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, Latest Edition.

Bids will be accepted based on the price index per gallon of asphalt as determined by the Alabama Department of Transportation for the month of December 2025. Any increase or decrease in the asphalt prices will be determined and adjusted by the price index for the month purchased.

Materials and work performed shall meet the current requirements of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, 2022 Edition as revised to one week before bid opening. To meet the requirements of 410.03 (c) 1, the clipping of grass from the pavement edges as well as the use of hand shovels and brooms for removing caked dirt and other foreign material may be required. Etowah County reserves the right to specify the mix of the bituminous plant-mix pavements listed in this bid package. When the mix is used as actual wearing surface, the use of carbonate stone such as limestone, dolomite, or other aggregates tending to polish under traffic will not be permitted in excess of the amounts shown in section 424.02 (c) Use of Carbonate Stone.

Test reports shall be submitted on all materials prior to final payment. Pay Estimates shall be submitted monthly and payment will be made after verification of estimates and test reports. All companies submitting bid must have Alabama State General Contractor's License and are required to submit a copy of the license with bid. Approved job mixes shall be submitted for each type mix used prior to beginning work. All bid items shall include portable construction signs, tack coat, and required milling at beginning and ending of project and at bridge ends.

Cost to be a subsidiary obligation of pay item being utilized. The Contractor will be given a minimum of ten (10) working days on each work order issued.

A vicinity map including estimated quantities and the number of working days allowed will be included with each work order issued. Cost of material past Ten (10) Miles from the source of supply plus a transportation cost factor of \$_____ per ton-mile from the source of supply of various project locations throughout the county will be used in determining the low bid. Due to this more than one (1) bid may be awarded. The Transportation cost (Mileage) shall be determined by the Etowah County Engineer. The County will measure the distance from the contractor's closest source of supply to the midway point of the project. The distance will be rounded to the nearest tenth (1/10) mile. The bid price per ton shall include hauling the material up to ten (10) miles. There will be no Transportation Cost added to the bid price per ton unless the haul distance is greater than ten (10) miles as determined by the County. The price per ton used will be determined by adding all plant mix items together to get the total sum, as determined on each mobilization. There may be more than one location and work order included on each mobilization.
