

Minutes of December 2, 2025 Wakarusa Town Council Meeting

Councilwoman Brown permission to proceed with the 2026 Lagoon Repairs and Booster Station projects. Councilman Gilbert seconds. Approved.

Councilman Klotz made a motion to approve Pay Application #15 to DLZ for the Water Treatment Plant in the amount \$39,087.50. Councilman Mitschelen seconds. Approved.

Councilman Gilbert made a motion to approve Pay Application #13 to R. Yoder Construction for the Water Treatment Plant in the amount of \$640,768.82. Councilwoman Brown seconds. Approved.

Councilwoman Brown made a motion to approve Pay Application #16 to DLZ for the Keystone Lift Station in the amount of \$5,790. Councilman Mitschelen seconds. Approved.
