Financial Report – Clerk, Dawn Pingel, went over the Town's financial report. Board thanked her.

Monthly Patrolman's Report – Discuss & possible action if needed – Patrolman, Todd Nevin, received a recall on the secondary boom for the tractor because it hits the first boom. Todd Nevin called Hillsboro Equipment and is waiting for a call back. Oakdale Electric will be in the area and cutting trees and Todd Nevin asked them about getting the one on Kettle Road. Cleaned out a few culverts and still working on trees. The plow truck's engine light came on and Todd Nevin would like to take it to Kimpton's to get it checked out. Spring cleanup is coming up and will be looking to get two dumpsters. Weight limit signs are up. The one-ton truck bed is rusted, and would like to take it to Hanson's to see if they can repair it. Board would like a quote first.

Dawn Pingel will also work at getting the current salt delivered.
