Hennes motioned to approve the agenda as presented and Cooling seconded. All ayes. Motion carried.

Public Hearing: Hennes made the motion to set SRF Public Hearing as November 12th at 7:00 PM. Cooling seconded. All ayes.

Ordinances and/or Resolution: Reihman motioned to approved the 28E agreement for provision of Law Enforcement service by Johnson County Sheriff's office. Hennes seconded. All ayes.

Library Report: Lauren reported 82 people attended fall book sale and made the highest amount ever at the book sale. The Library was awarded a grant from Brownstone book fund- the Library will receive 100 free books. Overall, the Library saw 331 patrons in the library and had 77 people attend programming in September.

Public Works: Hennes made the motion to approve a new snow plow bid for the F450. Reihman seconded the motion. All ayes.

Fire Report: New generator fully installed. Installed 3 new monitors to show calls coming in, that was paid for by Southslope grant. 96 calls so far for the year have come in on the fire side.

Clerks Report: Fire Budget was talked about creating a new line item. Council will still approve the budget and make decisions on money but this would make for easier tracking for their budget and tracking township funds etc. Jim will speak will other departments to figure out how their capital funds are processed and get back with clint and Taylor of how to move forward. Hennes motions to approve August clerks Report. Walters seconds. All ayes.

Other Business: Wage increase for Council and Mayor was discussed. Talk of \$50 per council member and mayor per meeting with quorum and annual payment of \$2500 for mayor. Council

and mayor are looking at numbers of what other councils receive and will be on agenda next month to vote upon for next election of council members.

Hennes made the motion to approve the Traveling Tapster to serve alcohol during LUO Dec 6th 2024. Walters seconded. All ayes.

City Council Comments: None.

Public Comments: Walters mentioned people speeding by on alley ways of main street. Deputy at meeting will patrol. Street closure discussion will be added to agenda for next month for LUO.
