### **CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION**

Tuesday, June 03,

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Presiding Commissioner Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

**4. AGENDA**

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. Commissioner Akey, Commissioner Hibler and Commissioner Howell voted in favor. The motion passed.

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Akey seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Hibler-yes, Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Jeff Campbell and Melissa Poje with Road & Bridge met with the commission to discuss purchasing a new software program. They presented the commission with two quotes: GWorks for \$5,500 and iWorQ for \$5,000. After reviewing the quotes, Commissioner Howell moved to accept the \$5,000 quote from iWorQ. Commissioner Akey seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Hibler-yes, Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Commissioners conducted an interview for the Planning & Zoning Administrator position.

Mark Merrill, Emergency Management Director met with the commission to report that he was finishing up the grant for the courthouse door lock system and that the county should receive reimbursement soon. They also discussed the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) team doing traffic counts for hazardous materials vehicles in Hamilton on Highway 36.

Mitch Allen-Sheriff, Rich Smith, Jessica Farmer & April Melte met with the commission to discuss the Law Enforcement and Caldwell County Detention Center 2025 budget.

Beverly Alden, Assessor met with the commission to discuss Commercial Real Estate Values.

Commissioner Akey reported that they would not be able to renew the CRP contract at Little Otter Creek because the adjoining landowner did not renew his contract.

Commissioners reviewed and signed Senior Tax Freeze applications.

Commissioners, Jamy Aubrey-Clerk, Beverly Alden-Assessor, and Tracy Bowen participated in a Webex training on Board of Equalization (BOE).

Commissioner Akey signed a grant agreement for 2024 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant awarding the Sheriff's Department \$9,999.81.
