Tree Trimming

Mayor Steve Myers has observed a lot of trees that are overgrown and hanging over streets, blocking sidewalks and street signs, and dead trees around town. The City cuts trees if they are in the power lines or pose an immediate danger to public safety. Private property owners are responsible for trimming their trees.

Councilmember Bill Hinchie brought up a few concerns, including speeding on Wood Street, speeding on Tennyson Road, and sidewalks on Tennyson Road towards Southwinds Drive. It was thought that a speed study was done recently on Wood Street; the speed study results will be reviewed. Additionally, he brought a suggestion from a community member about school zone speed limits being in effect only when school is in session. No decisions were made on these topics.
