

City of Allison Regular Council Meeting

Monday, February 9th, 2026

Regular Meeting:

Mayor Junker opened the regular meeting of the Allison City Council at 5:16 p.m. The council members present were Bangasser, Cramer, Galey, Henning, Heuer. Also present: Trent Stirling, Coby Bangasser, City Engineer Zeb Stanbrough, Joe Conlon, and Deb McWhirter. Henning made a motion to approve the agenda with a second by Bangasser. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Open Forum:

Mayor Junker let the council know that he reviewed the water shut off's with Deputy Utility Clerk, Chris Graser, in which there were 3 that needed to be shut off.

Mayor Junker let the council know that he will be leaving for a couple of weeks and canceled the first meeting in March (March 9th). That being said, there will be one meeting in March and it will take place on March 23rd, 2026.

Joe Conlon representing the Park let the Council know that they will be meeting with a boy scout leader on Wednesday to show him Wilder Park. The boy scout leader is looking to bring 120 boy scouts to tent camp the first weekend in May. When they are there, they will be working to receive badges through community/volunteer work.

Council member Heuer let the council know that the Park Board is looking to go out for bid on 7 acres of a hay field by the park. More details will come on this as they become available.

City Engineer Zeb Stanbrough, let the council know that he is still waiting to hear back from Heartland regarding the street project that was completed last fall as they are waiting on lien waivers.

City Administrator/City Clerk, Alexis Wiegmann reminded the council that she will be out of the office from Tuesday February 9, 2026, to Tuesday February 17th, 2026, and she will be returning to the office on Wednesday February 18th, 2026.

Mayor Junker let the council know that Striling lawn Care moved snow from 19 residential sidewalks who did not have their snow removed within 48 hours after the last snowstorm per the city ordinance.

Consent Agenda:

Motion by Henning with a second by Cramer to approve liquor license LC0044076 for Allison AMVETS. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Motion by Bangasser with a second by Heuer to approve the treasurer's report. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

New Business:

Council member Galey presented a mural idea to the council that the North Butler High School Art Teacher helped put together for the Paint Iowa Beautiful Grant. After reviewing the Mural that was presented, the council made the decision to hold off on the grant until they could put together a few more ideas for the mural and decide on one that everyone liked.

Old Business:

Mayor junker talked to the council regarding committees and told them that he would like to see a few new committees such as a township committee, Nuisance Abatement/sidewalk Committee, and more and would like to see members from the community on the committees with members from the council to help identify different tasks that need to be completed around town. This will allow the council and community to work together on different projects around Allison.

City Administrator/City Clerk, Alexis Wiegmann brought up a few long-term goals to the council that included Street projects, nuisance abatements, housing development, Cemetery, and City buildings. With these long-term goals in mind smaller goals will be able to be focused on to complete during the fiscal year. The long-term goals will continue to be looked at and added to as needed for forward progress.

Public Works Director, Trent Stirling, let the council know that he talked with a company regarding sewer jetting and televising. The city has around 39,000 feet that will need to be jetted/televised and put on 3-to-4-year rotation plan. The company he heard back from was quoting around \$2.15 per foot. The city will be going out for bid on this, and additional information on the bidding process will be discussed at a later date.
