

**VILLAGE OF GLENCOE
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-XX-XXXX**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DIVISION 7 OF ARTICLE V OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE
GLENCOE VILLAGE CODE REGARDING THE TERMS OF MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC
SAFETY COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Village of Glencoe is a home rule municipal corporation pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to, the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Division 7, of Article V, of Chapter 2 of the Glencoe Village Code (“*Village Code*”) establishes the Village’s Public Safety Commission, which is granted the power of a board of fire and police commissioners for the Village as set forth in Division 2.1 of Article X of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend Section 2-140 of the Village Code, entitled “Appointment; Term” to stagger the terms of members of the Village’s Public Safety Commission in the same manner as members of boards of fire and police commissioners are appointed under Division 2.1 of Article X of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that the best interests of the Village and its residents will be served by amending the Village Code as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENCOE, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION ONE: RECITALS. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in, and made a part of, this Ordinance by this reference as findings of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe.

SECTION TWO: AMENDMENT TO SECTION 2-140 OF THE VILLAGE CODE. Section 2-140, entitled "Appointment; Term," of Division 7, entitled "Public Safety Commission," of Article V, entitled "Boards and Commissions," of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration," of the Village Code shall be and is hereby amended as set forth in *Exhibit A* attached to and, by this reference, made a part of, this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.

Division 7. Public Safety Commission

§ 2-140 APPOINTMENT; TERM.

Members of the public safety commission shall be appointed by the village president with the consent of the board of trustees. The terms of office of members of the commission shall ~~end at the end of the village fiscal year~~ **commence upon appointment at the May meeting of the Board of Trustees** and shall, **except as provided in subsection (b) below,** be three years and until their respective successors shall be appointed and qualified; provided that:

(a) No appointment shall be made by the village president within 30 days before the expiration of his or her term;

(b) ~~The first appointments shall be for terms not to exceed one, two or three years, respectively,~~ **Commencing May of 2026, the village president shall appoint the three members of the board in staggered terms in the following manner. One of the members will be appointed to serve a term of one year, the second member will be appointed to serve a term of two years, and the third will be appointed to serve a term of three years.** ~~and they~~ **Notwithstanding the length of their appointed terms, each member** shall serve such term until their successors are appointed and qualified; and

(c) A vacancy on the commission shall be filled in the same manner as an original appointment.
