Notice is hereby given that the below listed proposed ordinances were introduced by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodstown, at its regular meeting held on Tuesday, April 28, 2026 and that public hearings thereon will be conducted by the Borough Council at its meeting on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at 7:00 pm at the Borough Hall, Woodstown after which the ordinances will be considered for adoption.

ORDINANCE 2026-5: CALENDAR YEAR 2026 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14). Purpose: Allow the Borough to exceed the budget appropriations increase limits and establish a CAP bank.

ORDINANCE 2026-6: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODSTOWN, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CREATING A CHAPTER FOR THE REGULATION OF SHORT-TERM DWELLING RENTAL UNITS. Purpose: Adds regulations over short term rental units.
