The grant is authorized under Section 85.21 of the Wisconsin Statutes and could support the Iron County Volunteer Driver Program, Bay Area Rural Transit and Highline, Inc transportation programs that transports aging (over 60) and disabled Iron County residents. The 2026 budget will include a state allocation of \$79,889 and a required county levy match of at least 20% (\$15,978).
