

A Special meeting of the Town of Avon was held on Monday, June 30, 2025, at 5:00 P.M. at the Avon Town Hall, 23 Genesee Street, Avon, New York 14414.

Dave Willard, MRB Group, started the discussion with updates on the emergency repairs and the estimates. The Villager gave an estimate on the 24-inch sewer pipe that is needed on Pole Bridge Road South area #3.

Pole Bridge Road South and Sackett Road will need new culverts.

Area#4, Pole Bridge Road North, was looked at and there is an eroded slope as well as below the shale ledge some roadside loss.

There was discussion on how this will need to be repaired and what materials will possibly be used. This could possibly add another couple hundred thousand to the estimate and will require a permit from NYS DEC since work will be done near or in the stream.

There was discussion on how the Town will pay for these added repairs.

Dave Willard discussed the possibility of opening part of the road while these repairs were getting done and Tom Crye is concerned with snow removal in the winter months in the area.

Further detailed discussion on how the roads will be repaired, what the estimate is on getting them open, if any of these repairs require us to bid out, how long will an emergency permit through NYS DEC take to obtain.

Dave Willard will work on getting more information for the Board to make decisions on repair work either by the Joint meeting on Monday July 7, 2025, or the Board meeting on July 10, 2025.

There was discussion on how to get the tree out of the gully on Sackett Road, and it was determined the Town employees cannot do it themselves, that a contractor will need to do it.

Supervisor LeFeber has been working with a few State leaders to get some funding/grant money and is working with Laurie Fox, MRB Group as well.

Tom Cyre is keeping track of the work that is being done by the Town Highway employees to give to the County as well.

The Town's main priority is to get these roads open and do it properly and some other Town business may take a backseat right now that isn't pertinent.

Dave Willard will reach out to NYS DEC and will work with Villager to give us an estimate and talk to them about removing the tree on Sackett Road.

The Joint meeting will start at 6:00PM instead of 5:00PM in the Village offices.

On motion of Deputy Supervisor Mairs seconded by Councilman Harrington the meeting was adjourned at 5:53 P.M.
