**5.1 Update from the American Legion #237 and Veterans of Foreign Wars #6298**

Mr. Dennis Pearce provided an update on American Legion Post #237, noting that the Ham Radio Club is active. He reported that American Legion members attended the Camp Parks graduation ceremonies, hosted the Sea Cadets at Veterans Memorial Hall, supported the Camp Parks Valentine's Party, and welcomed a Cub Scout den to the American Legion Museum.
