

Grafton City Council Proceedings  
August 11, 2025

Mayor Pro Tem Tom Kruger convened the regular meeting of the Grafton City Council at 7 PM, August 11, 2025 at Grafton City Hall. Answering roll call were Dalluge, Fossey, Hulshizer, and Schaub. Visitor was Bruce White. Fossey motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dalluge to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Hulshizer motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Schaub to approve the minutes from the July 14, 2025 meeting. Motion carried.

Clerk presented the financial reports, past due utility accounts, and bills to be paid. Dalluge motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Fossey to approve the financial reports as presented and pay all bills due to date. Motion carried.

Resolution #2025-10 to certify a lien against real estate at 309 3<sup>rd</sup> Street was reviewed. Schaub motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Fossey to approve the resolution. Upon roll call vote, all council members voted aye. Resolution #2025-10 is passed and approved. Resolution #2025-11 to certify a lien against real estate at 305 3<sup>rd</sup> Street was reviewed. Fossey motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Schaub to approve the resolution. Upon roll call vote, all council members voted aye. Resolution #2025-11 is passed and approved. The clerk will file the liens with the Worth County Treasurer.

Ordinance #2025-3 concerning amending the refuse collection rate by adopting new rates for these services was presented. The new rates will be as follows: For each resident with bag service, charges shall be \$15.50 per month in addition to a charge of \$1.50 for each sticker. For container service, the charge will be \$20.00 for a small, or \$22.00 for a large container per month for one garbage collection per week. Dalluge motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Schaub to adopt Ordinance #2025-3 and to waive the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> readings of this ordinance. Upon roll call vote, all council members voted aye. Ordinance #2025-3 is passed, approved, and adopted.

Under old business, grant ideas were discussed. Under new business, the clerk informed the council that nomination papers are now available at City Hall. They can be turned into the clerk's office starting Monday, August 25<sup>th</sup>. They must be received by Thursday, September 18, 2025 at 5 PM. The city will be electing a mayor and 5 council members for two-year terms. There being no further business, Fossey motioned, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dalluge for adjournment. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 7:58 PM.
