

ORDINANCE NO. 2683

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF FUNDING FROM THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,116,000 FOR THE CHAMBERS ROAD WIDENING PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Congressionally Directed Spending allows members of Congress to request funding for specific projects in their district; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) applied for Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2024 Congressionally Directed Spending for the Chambers Road Widening Project; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded funding through the FY 2024 Congressionally Directed Spending process for the Chambers Road Widening project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare and in public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The 2025 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize funds from the Colorado Department of Transportation totaling \$4,116,000 and to appropriate such funds in the Capital Expenditures Fund (Fund 395) for a total of \$4,116,000.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
