

**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR INDEPENDENT ETHICS
COUNSEL TO HOFFMANN PARKER WILSON & CARBERRY, P.C.**

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Commerce City (“City”) adopted a new Ethics Code, which establishes an Independent Ethics Counsel to review ethics complaints and prosecute charges on behalf of the City if a public hearing is necessary; and

WHEREAS, Corey Hoffmann with Hoffmann Parker Wilson & Carberry, P.C. has been selected to be the City’s Independent Ethics Counsel.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Award of Contract. The award of the contract for Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to Hoffman Parker Wilson & Carberry, P.C. (“Contractor”) is hereby approved. This resolution shall not be deemed to grant any right or interest in the award of a contract to Contractor. All rights and interests shall be defined exclusively by the terms and conditions set forth in the written contract.

SECTION 2. Execution and Attestation. Upon approval as to form by the City Attorney’s Office, the City Attorney is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the contract or any amendment thereto on behalf of the City.
