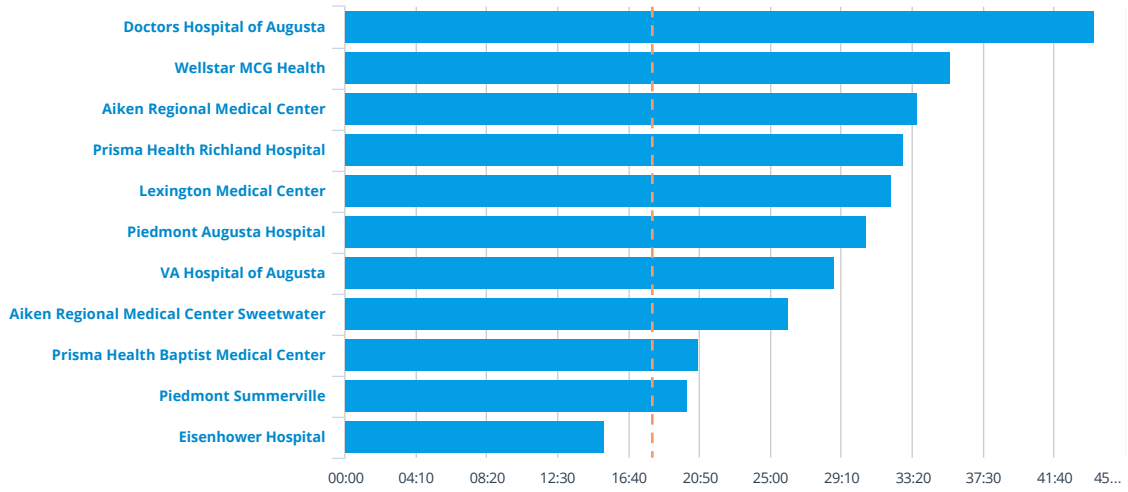

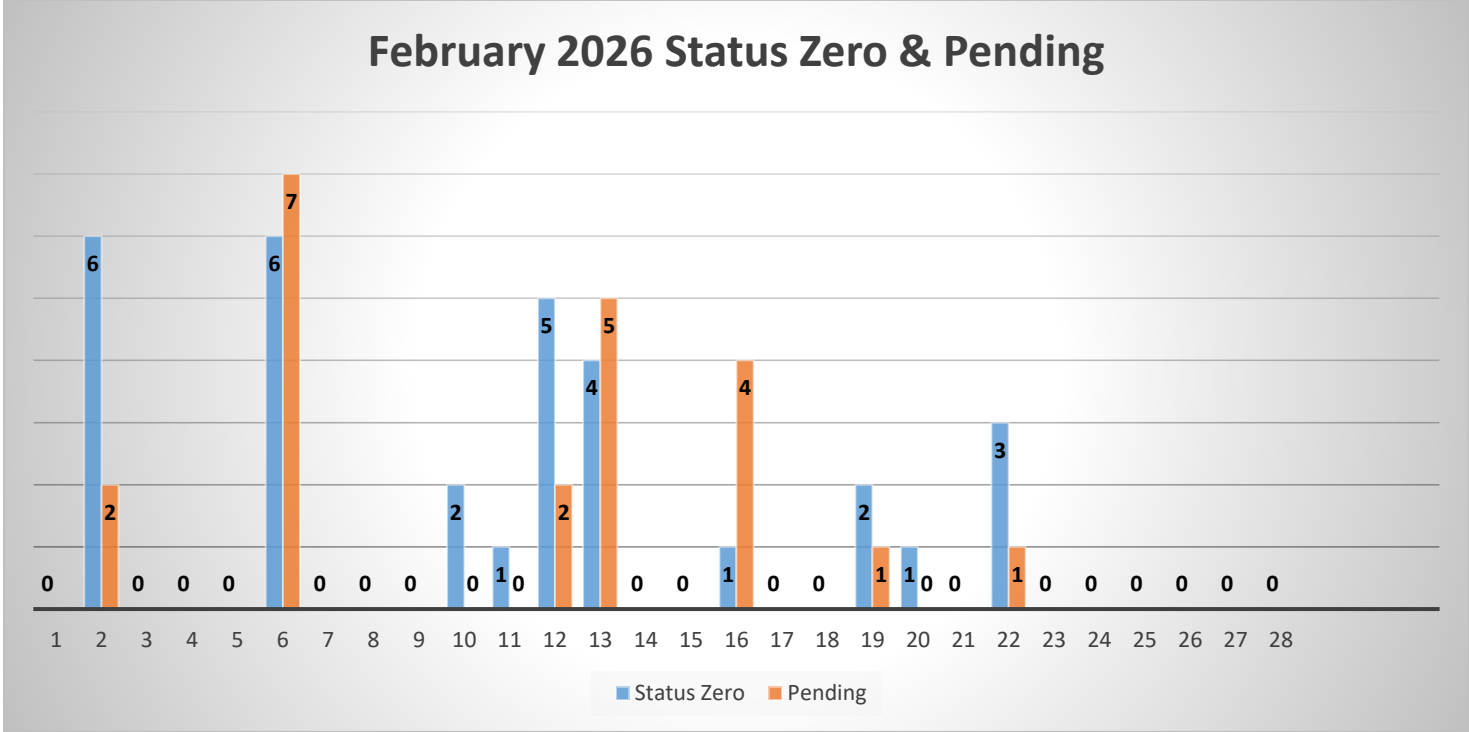

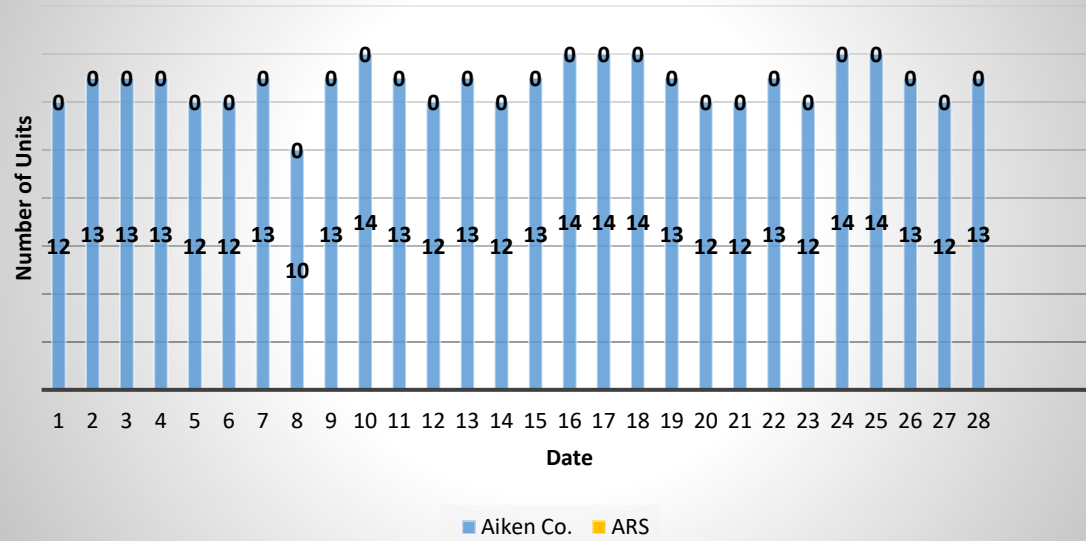

## **MINUTES**

**Re:** **Minutes for the Judicial & Public Safety Committee, February 3, 2026**

Calling the meeting to order at 5:30 pm, with the Honorable Danny Feagin, PRESENT; the Honorable Sandy Haskell, PRESENT; and the Honorable Phil Napier, PRESENT; the Judicial and Public Safety Committee took the following actions:

**Councilman Haskell made a motion to elect Danny Feagin as Committee Chairman, and Councilman Feagin made a motion to elect Phil Napier as Vice Chairman of the Committee. Both motions were unanimously approved.**

1. Discussion of Emergency Services & Communications Boards. **(JPS pp. 1-11)**  
**Councilman Haskell made a motion to amend the Code to remove this boards. Councilman Napier seconded the motion. The Committee unanimously approved to have staff draft up an Ordinance for the next meeting to remove these two committees from the County code.**
2. Update Regarding the New Emergency Radios.  
*(Captain Rick Sullivan, ACSO)*  
**Certain fire departments want additional radios, but Capt. Sullivan voiced to Council that the costs for additional radios or equipment should be taken out of each departments individual budget based on their additional wants.**
3. Resolution to Declare Used Coats as Surplus and Donate Them to the Salvation Army Aiken.  
**(Council Agenda p. 7) Unanimously recommended for approval.**
4. First Reading of an Ordinance to Authorize the Council Chairman to Execute an Intergovernmental Agreement Between The City of New Ellenton and Aiken County, South Carolina for Certain Code Enforcement Activities.  
**(Council Agenda pp. 8-16) Unanimously recommended for approval.**
5. First Reading of an Ordinance to Authorize the Council Chairman to Execute an Intergovernmental Agreement Between the Town of Burnettown and Aiken County, South Carolina for Certain Code Enforcement Activities.  
**(Addendum pp. 1-11) Unanimously recommended for approval.**
6. Monthly Fire Department Run Report  
**-No report given, but will have January numbers included with the March JPS reports.**
7. EMS Status Update Report- December 2025. **(JPS pp. 12-14)**  
*(We are still waiting to get final numbers from January 2026, so that report will be handed out at the meeting)* **Received as information.**
8. Approve Committee Minutes from January 6, 2026. **(JPS p. 15) Unanimously approved.**
9. Executive Session (if needed).
